Research shows that homework on the elementary level doesn't effect student achievement. On the other hand research supports that reading every night for 20 minutes provides significant benefits. I will expect students to read every night. Occasionally your child will have writing homework or a special project that may require extra time outside of school. The homework will be sent home in the Bach folder on Friday. Unless otherwise noted, please return the homework the following Friday. Homework should take no longer than 30 minutes to complete. If homework is taking longer, please contact me so that we can come up with a solution. I don't want homework to be a stressful situation at home for your family.

The 3rd Grade math curriculum provides students with mathematical experiences that help them develop number sense and a positive attitude towards mathematics. The Everyday Math curriculum teaches students math concepts using multiple methods. Students receive direct whole group instruction. Then they are able to practice the skills with a small group, with a partner or independently. They also get an opportunity to reinforce the concepts through hands on explorations and math games.



You must send a **note** if your child will be going home with another child or adult. Please let me know any time your child's dismissal plans are different than a typical day.





Practice your math facts at home whenever you have a spare minute or two. Driving in the car, kids bored? Practice your basic facts! It is so important for your child to master math facts.

We will have Guided Reading for 60-75 minutes every day. Children will meet in guided reading groups and read books at their own instructional level. When the students aren't meeting with me they will be engaged in centers that enrich reading. The students are given tasks and goals, based on a whole group mini lesson, for their reading time.

3rd Grade report cards will be sent home three times a year: in November, March and June.

3rd Graders have lunch **recess** every day. We also have recess in the afternoon. Please dress your child appropriately for outdoor play.



I'm very excited to begin incorporated a website called Seesaw. It is a student portfolio that parents will be able to view and make comments daily! I'll present detailed info at curriculum night.

Your child should bring a fruit/vegetable **snack** to school every day. Due to allergies in our room, we will have fruits/vegetables throughout the year. We will have snack time in the morning since our lunch is late.

Your child will occasionally get Scholastic book orders sent home. We receive bonus points for this order, which I will use to build our classroom library! We need more 3rd grade chapter books. Thank you in advance for your support.
